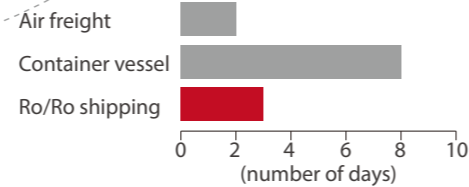
The 'Hakata Cross Service'

High-speed roll-on/roll-off shipping offers a significant time and cost saving when compared to standard shipping.

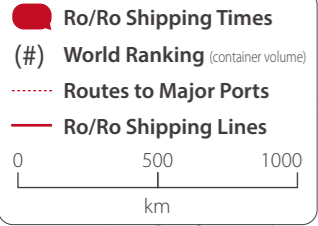
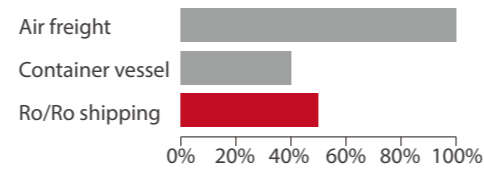


Hakata Cross Service Ro/Ro Ship

Well Established Overland Shipping Network

Kyushu has a well developed network of highways and railways that are highly efficient and less crowded than other urban areas in Japan, with the Shinkansen bullet train connecting Hakata to Osaka in just 2.5 hours and Tokyo in only 5 hours.
